Your trash assessment covers your trash bin and three extra bags per week. If you have a large amount of trash, you will have to make arrangements with Waste Management for a special pick up. In order to keep the edges of the new roads from breaking up and the curbs in subdivisions from being disturbed, the Bay County Road Commission has asked that you please put your trash carts, yard waste, and recycle containers in front of the curb on the asphalt in subdivisions. On local roads, put the containers near the edge of road, preferably in portion of driveway. **NOTE:** Containers that are more than six (6) feet from the edge of road will not be picked up.

PREPARATION GUIDE FOR RECYCLING

Put your bins out on the curbside for pickup by 6:00 a.m. on the same day as your trash pickup. See schedule on reverse for recycling weeks. Materials must be rinsed and uncontaminated. Dirty, improperly prepared or unacceptable materials cannot be collected.

LARGE ITEM PICKUP: Large items may be put out on your regular trash day, but may be picked up the next day by a separate truck. Our contract is for one large item a week. Waste Management: (800) 796-9696. Christmas trees are collected the first two (2) weeks in January.

YARD WASTE: Yard Waste is picked up from April 1st through November 30th. **Your pickup day is the day after your regular trash day** and includes leaves, grass clippings, garden waste, twigs, and branches less than 3 inches in diameter. Branches & brush must be in bundles less than 4 feet in length and 2 feet in diameter. Compost materials must be placed either in rigid containers labeled "YARD WASTE" (permanent marker or spray paint) or placed in brown paper yard waste bags. Stickers are no long being provided. Containers must weigh less than 50 pounds. Yard waste in plastic bags will not be accepted.
