MONITOR PARK RULES

The following Rules and Regulations were established by the Monitor Township Board of Trustees. Please read them carefully. Remember, the parks are here for everyone's enjoyment. If you have any questions please call the office at 684-7203.

Permission for "Special Events" that would otherwise breach any of these rules may be granted only by the Township Board.

RULES:

- 1) Monitor Park is open from May 1 through September 30.**
- 2) Park hours are 8:00 a.m. to dusk.**
- 3) No driving on the lawn for any reason.**
- 4) No commercial or fundraising uses allowed.**
- 5) No alcoholic beverages allowed on park property.**
- 6) Public address systems, loud speakers, etc., are not allowed.**
- 7) Fireworks or firearms of any kind are not allowed.**
- 8) No ground fires. Fires to be built in grills for cooking purposes only.**
- 9) Defacing or removal of park property, including plants, is prohibited.**
- 10) Speed limit within the park is not to exceed 10 m.p.h.**
- 11) No off road vehicles, motorcycles or snowmobiles allowed.**

Bounce House Policy

Anyone wishing to put up a Bounce House or similar inflatable in Monitor Township Parks is required to do the following:

1. Deliver to the Township a one million dollar liability insurance policy related to placement of the bounce house.
2. Provide your own source of electricity (generator) for its operation.
