

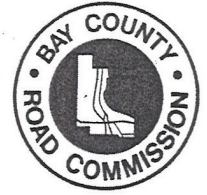

To all Concrete Contractors, General Contractors, Asphalt Contractors and Township Official's

RE: Concrete Driveways Within the Bay County Road Right-of-Way

To whom it may concern;

Due to significant noncompliance issues relating residential driveway (permits) or lack thereof, we are sending out a friendly notification to all of contractor addresses that we have on file. Our hope with this notification is to avoid costly rework and reduce the number of unpermitted activities.

This notification is intended to be a reminder to all recipients that concrete driveway approach construction is NOT allowed within the Bay County road right-of-way. Pursuant to the Residential Driveway Policy, latest revision dated May 2, 2012, concrete drive approach pavements are NOT ALLOWED within in the right-of-way, exclusive of a curb and gutter roadways. Refer to the aforementioned policy for all specific requirements and restrictions pertaining to the policy.

As a notice, if concrete is installed within the right-of-way, the permittee will receive notification that an UNPERMITTED appurtenance has been placed within the right-of-way and the appurtenance shall be removed within 30 days. Removal will be at the sole expense of the permittee including the cost to permit the removal. Noncompliance extending beyond 30 days will be subject to removal be BCRC restored to a surface as determined by BCRC, with full cost billed to the permittee.

Permits are required for ALL work in a road right-of-way. Permits can be obtained at our Permit Office located at 2600 E. Beaver Road, Kawkawlin, MI 48631 or online at www.baycoroad.org. Thank you for your cooperation.
