Facility Reporting Requirements Regarding Hazardous Materials

According to Section 5p of the Michigan Fire Prevention Code (Act 207), facilities licensed under the Medical Marihuana Facilities Licensing Act (MMFLA) must provide the following information to the fire chief within their jurisdiction regarding hazardous chemicals:

- A list of hazardous chemicals on site and a Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS) for each chemical on the list.
- A description of the quantity and location of any hazardous chemical specified by the fire chief after review of the list.

There are three emergency planning requirements that fire departments and/or the communities they serve must meet, which are listed below. These are required to ensure firefighter safety and there are no exemptions based on quantity of chemical at the site.

- Firefighter Right to Know
- Hazardous Waste Operations and Emergency Response
- Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act, Title III
